The new billet list will reflect the total number of officers authorized by law; currently 299. The grade distribution of the 299 billets is as follows:

Lieutenant 23%  
Lieutenant (jg) 18%  
Ensign 18%

As the authorized strength of the Corps increases or decreases, so will the number of billets. Upon completion of this review, a new billet list will be posted on our web site and in the NOAA Corps Bulletin.
