Director's Message

In order to better serve the NOAA Corps family, CPC will be processing all Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders at least 120 days prior to the officers' scheduled rotation date. This will allow ample time for the officers to make arrangements with GSA for any transportation of household goods and POVs (if authorized). To make this process work, we need to receive the NOAA form 56-26 at least 150 days prior to the officers' scheduled rotation date. Once orders are processed, officers will receive an email indicating the orders are available in their online OPF. Please remember that GSA is the only authorized agent to arrange household goods and POV shipments. Also, ADTRAV is the only authorized agent for scheduling commercial flights. Promotion Update

During an Executive Session of the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation, nominations were passed and forwarded to the Secretary of the Senate and placed on the Executive Calendar. When the calendar is cleared they will be forwarded to the President for approval. Then, CPC will prepare and submit the package to promote officers based on vacancies back to NOAA and DOC.

Important Information for Officers Eligible for Promotion Year 2008

All NOAA Corps officers are required to have a current (annual or 5 year periodic) physical examination and a current dental exam (class I or class II) on file with the Medical Administration Branch at CPC. The deadline for the submission of medical records for the 2008 promotion year is January 31, 2008. Documentation submitted after the deadline will not be considered for the 2008 promotion year. This may require you to plan and get your physical or dental exams completed before they expire.

Officers should contact LCDR Hobson-Powell in the Medical Administration Branch via E-mail (Elizabeth.hobson-powell@noaa.gov) over the next few weeks to ensure that you have a current periodic physical examination and all required medical documents are on file.

PLEASE NOTE: Upon review of your medical documents, the Medical Administration Branch will notify you via E-mail if additional documents are required.

TRICARE Retiree Dental Program

On April 16, 2007 a final ruling regarding the TRICARE Retiree Dental Program to overseas locations was published in the Federal Register by the Department of Defense. The current TRDP is only applicable authorized providers in the 50 United States and District of Columbia, Canada, Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands and the U.S. Virgin Islands. Expansion of the geographic scope will ensure that all TRICARE eligible retirees are eligible for the same dental benefits, regardless of their location.
