Completed Projects

- NJAC Charter: Revised version submitted to CPC and the Admirals.
- Medical Webinar Series: NJAC brought medical questions and concerns from officers to Medical Affairs. The medical webinar series was led by Captain Rathke providing clarification on medical matters.
- Created an Insignia Swap Facebook group page for officers to trade insignia or extra uniform parts. This will help offset the costs associated with purchasing new insignia.

Current Projects in Progress

- BOTC Sponsor Initiative: Started the pilot program for a NOAA Corps officer to act as a
 mentor and to meet with BOTC several times throughout the program, as well as attend
 graduation. LTJG Justin Miyano was selected as the sponsor for BOTC 136 and has
 been through mentorship training from CPC.

 for shipboard personnel and available resources provided. This will allow for continuity of
 posts to the general public about NOAA missions and achievements.
