Boots to Business

Boots to Business (B2B) is an entrepreneurial education and training program offered by the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) as part of the Department of Defense's Transition Goals, Plans, & Success (GPS) Program. The curriculum includes steps for evaluating business concepts, the foundational knowledge required to develop a business plan and information on SBA resources available to help access start-up capital and additional technical assistance.

Accessing Higher Education

Accessing Higher Education (AHE) guides and assists service members pursuing college education with preparation for the college application process. This course will guide you through the variety of decisions involved in choosing a program, preparing for the college admissions application process, and securing funding. The expected outcome is that participants will create a customized plan for successful transition to a higher education institution.

Career Technical Training

Conducted by the Department of Labor, the Career Technical Training Track (CTTT) assists service members in transitioning to civilian life, while navigating through the choices and decisions involved in selecting a technical career. Participants will receive assistance in identifying required credentials and investigating training options to pursue those qualifications. During CTTT, participants will define their personal technical career goals; identify required credentials; find technical training opportunities; identify local Veteran resources; and create a plan to utilize their VA education benefits.
